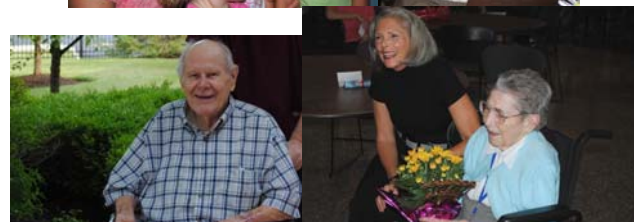


Our Annual Resident & Family Appreciation Picnic at Drake was a Great Success!

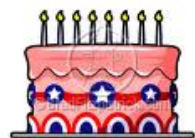

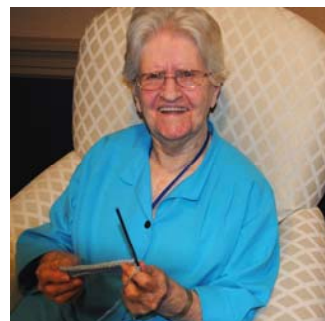

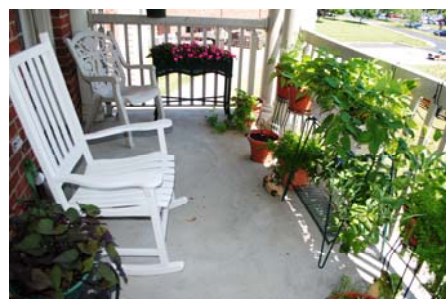
